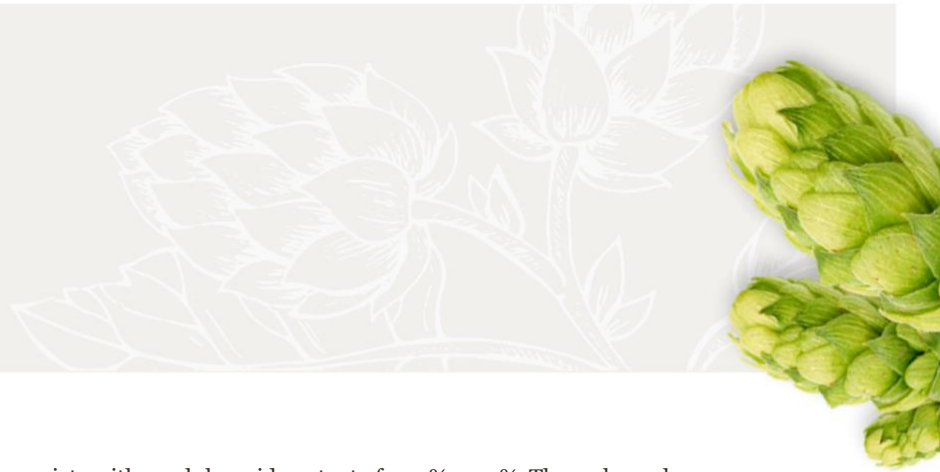


SUPER PRIDE

Fruity, Citrusy, Cedar & Herbal



OVERVIEW

Super Pride Hops is a super alpha variety bittering variety with an alpha acid content of 13.5%-15.0%. The co-humulone content in this variety is somewhat low, ranging from 26.8%-28.0%. Aside from the nearly double alpha acid content, Super Pride carries some of the same characteristics as Pride of Ringwood.

BITTERNESS

Super Pride is Australian bred giving beer the “Australian” flavour. The aroma is present, and has a combination of spice, citrus and fruit in its bouquet.

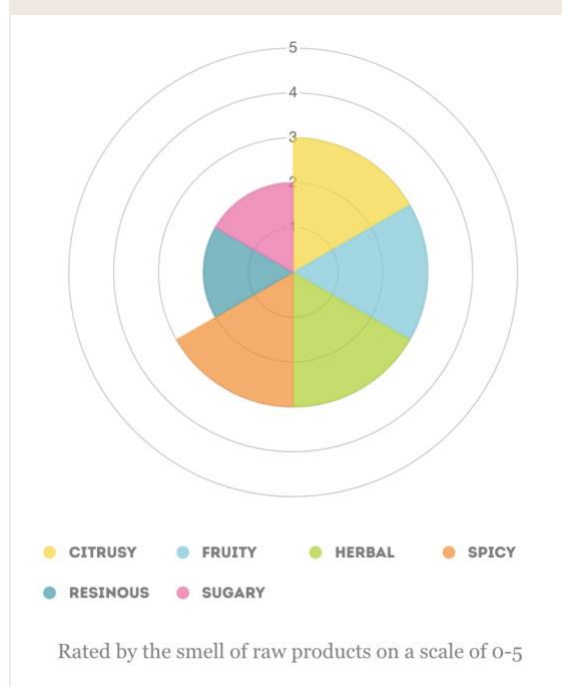

ALPHA ACID	12.5 – 14.5% w/w
BETA ACID	5.0 – 8.0% w/w
CO-HUMULONE % REL	25.0 - 39.0

CHEMICAL INGREDIENTS – AROMA COMPONENTS

TOTAL OILS	2.0 – 2.5 ml/100g
MYRCENE	19.0 – 35.0%
HUMULENE	1.0 – 2.0%
CARYOPHYLLENE	5.0 – 8.0%
FARNESENE	<1.0%
