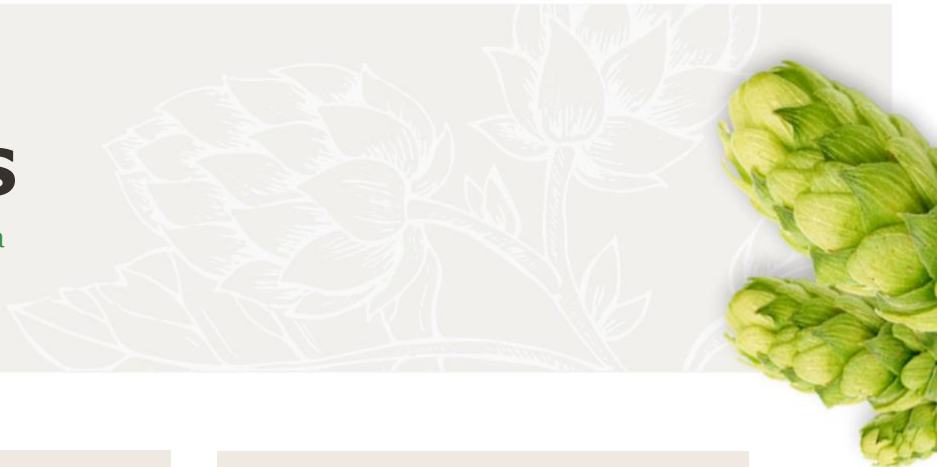

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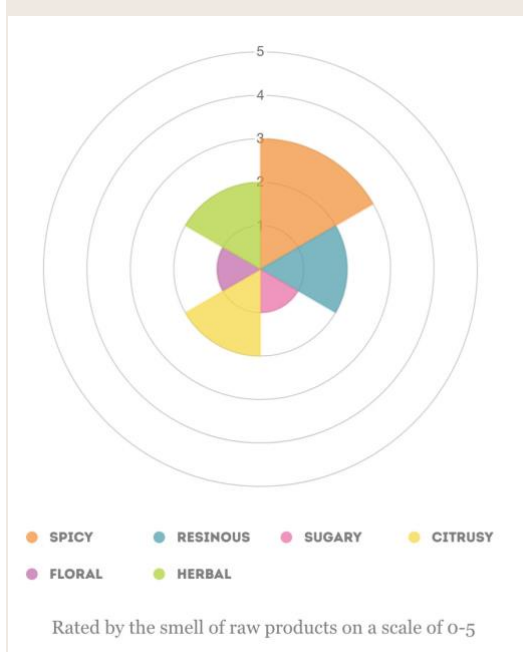
## CHEMICAL INGREDIENTS – BITTER COMPONENTS

<b>ALPHA ACID</b>	4.0 – 7.0%
<b>BETA ACID</b>	2.0 – 3.0%
<b>CO-HUMULONE</b>	23.0 – 25.0%
<b>HARD RESINS : ALPHA-ACID</b>	0.38 – 0.86%

## CHEMICAL INGREDIENTS – AROMA COMPONENTS

<b>TOTAL OILS</b>	0.6 – 1.0 ml/100g
<b>BETA-CARYOPHYLLENE : HUMULENE</b>	0.3– 0.39%
<b>FARNESENE % OF TOTAL OIL</b>	0.0 – 4.5%
<b>LINALOOL % OF TOTAL OIL</b>	1.0 – 1.1%
